

**Candles are special.....
.....so take special care
Every time you light one in your home**

GREAT CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN WHEN USING CANDLES, SO FOLLOW THIS SIMPLE FIRE SAFETY ADVICE.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

- Advisable to remove candle decoration from candle before burning.
- Always place candles well away from curtains, furniture and drapes and always out of draughts
- Keep candle out of the reach of young children & pets
- Gel wax container will become hot during use. Do not touch or move until extinguished and fully cooled
- Never leave a burning candle unattended
- Keep candles away from hair and clothing
- Keep the wick trimmed to 1cm to avoid excessive smoking.
- Always place candles upright in suitable holders, which cannot fall over easily
- Never extinguish the candle with water or by blowing it out. Always extinguish your candle with a snuffer
- Do not place in a draught when lit, they can cause a flame to be blown to one side, smoke and cause the candle to dribble
- Always make sure that candles are properly extinguished, especially before going to bed

Candle transfers are DECORATIVE transfers so should be handled and treated with care like paintings, and not exposed to direct sunlight as the colours will fade in strong UV light, or if placed in freezing temperatures the transfer could crinkle.

Avoid placing the candle in a window that receives direct sunlight, some of the colours fade and on hot days the candles can become sufficiently soft to sag.

Do not place the candle into water as the transfer could separate from the candle, and would need to be reset onto the candle. Take care of your candle and it will be a keepsake forever.
